

The goal of the Language, Culture and Church for International Priests Program (LCCIP) at Conception ▲ Seminary College (CSC) is to provide opportunities for international priests and to better understand and to be better understood in their service to the American Catholic Church. This is carried out through a four-week program of morning sessions centered on accent reduction and American English language development and afternoon presentations centered on sacramental ministry to cover the American culture and many other varied aspects of priestly life in the United States.

Each priest will also take his turn as principal celebrant and homilist and it will be videographed and critiqued with them. Sponsoring dioceses will help identify areas of needed attention and will receive an evaluation for each of their program participants.

Afternoons are devoted to the following topics:

The Sacraments of Christian Initiation

- Infant Baptism, Confirmation & the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults
- Youth Ministry

The Sacrament of Orders

- Collaborating with Bishop and Presbyterate
- Professional Boundaries and Collaborating with Laity (women and consecrated religious)


Participants will be free for weekend supply in T their home dioceses or for excursions to the local areas of interest.
